

## **Appendix 8.B**

# **Schedule of viewpoints to be used to inform the landscape and visual assessments of the Moorside Site and the Accommodation Sites**



# 1. Introduction

The locations of the photographic viewpoint set out in schedules included this appendix have been agreed through consultation with Natural England, Copeland Borough Council, Cumbria County Council, the Lake District National Park Authority, Friends of the Lake District and the National Trust that has taken place during a series of regular meetings throughout 2015 and early 2016.

Viewpoint locations have been agreed in relation to the Moorside Site and the Accommodations Sites at Corkickle, Mirehouse and Egremont. Consultation to identify viewpoint locations that may be required in relation to the other sites comprising the Moorside Project will be undertaken with the organisations listed above in 2016. The locations of viewpoints for the Moorside Site are shown on **Figure 8.6**, those for the Corkickle Site on **Figure 8.10**, the Mirehouse Site on **Figure 8.14** and the Egremont Site on **Figure 8.18**.

It should be noted that the locations included in the schedules represent a subset of a larger number of locations that have been considered and discounted. A schedule of locations that have been considered and discounted (together with rationale) will be included in the ES for the DCO submission. It is also important to note that the locations selected as photographic viewpoints represent a much smaller subset of the locations that have been visited and at which field observations have been made by the landscape and visual assessors.
