The Stage Two Proposed Scheme Consultation consists of a number of documents relating to the proposed Moorside Project.

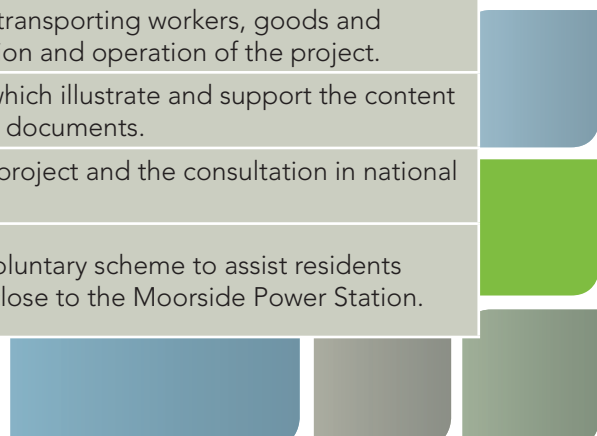

• Draft Outline Construction Environment Management Plan	The Draft Outline CEMP provides the outline structure of how environmental issues during the construction period will be managed on site.
• Draft Outline Biodiversity Management Strategy	This is the NuGen strategy which outlines how it intends to think about ecological and biodiversity management for the Moorside Project.
• Draft Transport Strategy	Sets out NuGen's strategy for transporting workers, goods and materials during the construction and operation of the project.
• Plans and Drawings	Provides drawings and plans which illustrate and support the content of the Stage Two Consultation documents.
• Notice of Proposed Application under s48 Planning Act 2008	Formal notice advertising the project and the consultation in national and local publications.
• Draft Property Support Scheme and Draft Local Mitigation Scheme	Draft proposals for NuGen's voluntary scheme to assist residents owners within a defined area close to the Moorside Power Station.
