The 10-week public consultation on NuGen's proposed Moorside Project will start with an event at the Moorside Information Centre in Whitehaven's Civic Hall, Lowther Street on the 16th May between 10.30am and 3pm.

Throughout the 10-week consultation period, NuGen's consultation team will be available at more than 20 events across Cumbria to talk you through our plans for a new nuclear power station on land to the west and north of Sellafield.
